Clam Bayou, St Pete: just 3 MMBG volunteers managed to pulled more then 700 lbs of trash and 1 inflatable mattress out of the water

Anclote Key, Pasco Coast: 22 volunteers pulled 3,350 lbs of trash, 21 tires, 1 hibachi grill, 1 boogie board, 1 marine hatch door, 1 patio chair, 3 crab pots, 3 sheets of plywood, 1 inflatable raft and 2 Navy flare practice markers.

Old Post Rd canal: 2 volunteers pulled nearly 400 illegally dumped Yellow Pages phone books

3 Rooker Key, Pinellas coast: 7 volunteers pulled 1100 lbs of trash, 46 tires, 2 crab pots, 2 coolers and 1 large section of boat deck.

FEELING DUCKY PROJECT: Our youngest volunteer set out to raise awareness to prevent trash getting into our storm drains. She marked 223 Storm Drains in the Holiday area.

Kelsey's Senior Project restore and return wetland project: we helped one of our high school seniors excel with her school project, making this clean up one of our largest ever, pulling nearly 34 tons of illegally dumped trash from the Pasco Palms wetland area in Holiday; with the strength of 39 volunteers.

Anclote Gulf Park and Fishing Pier: 11 volunteers pulled 1700lbs of trash that included 4 trash bags filled with monofilament line.
